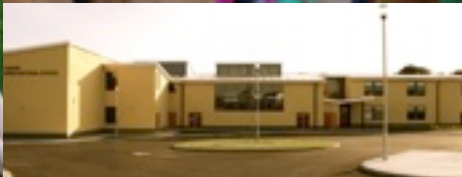
Please also pray that we would be able to identify potential longterm leaders that we can train and equip to carry the church well into the future. Our hope is that 2012 would be a big year in this regard!

BIG ANSWER TO PRAYER! 8 years in the making

For the past 8 years, we have sent out an annual communique asking (sometimes desperately) for prayer as we sent in our request to the Irish Immigration authorities for a continuation of our permission to remain in Ireland.

I am happy to report that Mandy and I are now in the final stages of becoming Irish citizens (the kids already are). Fees have been paid and photos sent. All that remains for us is to attend a ceremony at a date as-of-yet undetermined. While this won't affect our US citizenship, it will give us an unfettered freedom to remain in Ireland for as long as God would have us here.

Please continue to pray as we wait for the final stroke of the pen and the official certificates. Very specifically, we need for it to happen soon because, while we have been approved, we still have to maintain a current visa until we are officially naturalized. This would need to be done before March 6, 2012!
